About Core Shack

A cornerstone of Mineral Exploration Roundup, Core Shack showcases new discoveries, leading prospects, advanced projects, and operating mines from around the world. Core Shack 2010 saw core displays from projects in 12 countries, representing a diverse suite of deposit types and commodities. The 2010 program included one day devoted to projects from BC, the Yukon and Alaska; one day devoted to primarily international projects; and one day devoted to North American projects. Commodities featured in 2010 included copper, gold, silver, lead, zinc, molybdenum, rhenium, nickel, lead, VMS, PGEs, and polymetallics.

Core Shack provides an excellent cross-section of new developments in the exploration and mining sectors. A new suite of the sectors most compelling projects will be displayed each day, with maps, cross-sections, and the project's technical representative on hand to answer questions.

Selection Process

The Roundup Core Shack Committee determines who will participate. Interested companies are welcome to apply by submitting page 2 of this form before October 1, 2010. Selected companies will be formally confirmed to participate by letter from the Committee. Confirmation letters will be sent out by December 1, 2010. Due to the volume of applications received, if you apply and do not receive a confirmation letter by December 1, 2010, please assume your company was not selected to participate in Core Shack 2011.

Confirmed Participants

Each confirmed company will be allocated one 10' wide x 8' deep booth in the Core Tent. Each booth will come with one 4'x8' free standing pin board, two 6' covered and skirted tables, and two chairs. Each participating company will be required to submit an abstract for the conference abstract volume by October 29. There is no fee to participate in Core Shack, however all representatives will be required to register for the conference (in order to have access to the Core Tent).
